RCGP Midland Faculty Leadership Development Programme in Association with Keele University

This programme is for any member of the primary healthcare team wishing to further their expertise within the area of Leadership and Management. The aim is that participants will develop and strengthen their leadership potential to support, inspire and lead change looking for enhanced service delivery and ultimately better patient care.

What does it involve? This is a nine month long programme based around a workplace based service improvement project leading to a 60 M-Level credit Postgraduate Certificate in Leadership and Management. The Keele Leadership and Management in Healthcare module will give a theoretical introduction and there will be one optional module, reflecting your personal emphasis, chosen from: Health Informatics; The Interface between Primary and Secondary Care; Rational Prescribing; Research Methods; Chronic Disease Management; Clinical Effectiveness; Medical Education; and Statistics and Epidemiology.

An RCGP Midland Faculty project leader will be appointed as course tutor to support you as you work through your project and organize extra study days and workshops to suit the group.

Outline timetable

- One 24 hour residential session (7 November 2010)
- Leadership and Management module: Five-day block at Keele (8-12 November 2010)
- Up to five workshops arranged to support the projects, depending on the needs of the group
- Optional Module: five further days during the academic year
- Workplace-based project with demonstrable service improvement
- Individual self-directed study and project management
- Final conference to showcase completed projects

What does it cost? The cost of the Certificate is £1750. Bursaries for 66% may be available from the Midland Faculty or from your Trust.
