Commissioning priorities 2013-2014

Reform Secondary care pathways

- More practice facing services
- Improved engagement between MH providers and CCGs
- Improved engagement between secondary care and primary care MH providers
- Build on existing track record with active service user involvement



Commissioning priorities 2013-2014

Improving Access to Psychological Therapies

- Tiers 2 + 3 and 3+ – IAPT under AQP
- Tier 4 – Psychological therapies review

Continue to Make Efficiencies

- Positive results regarding QIPP for Individual Placements - £2M in efficiencies
- Improved experience for patients and carers

Improved Pathways for people with diagnosis of ASD

- Diagnostic service in place
- Consultation on a ASD hub



Commissioning priorities 2013-2014

Improve the physical health of those with SMI

- Increased public health funding
- CQUIN in main contract

Local Area Co-ordination Pilot

- Help people who do not access services to achieve potential
- Help those who **do** want services to access them

Challenges Ahead

Shared care arrangements.

- Dementia care
- Physical health of people with SMI

Spread of resources/equity of service provision

- Financial allocation have made intentions more of a challenge
