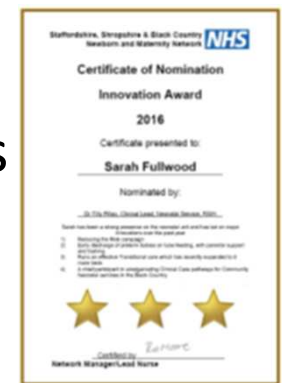
The Innovation Award
