

How to find Walsall Manor Hospital

Walsall Manor Hospital is signposted on all major routes into town. The hospital is situated just off the A454 (Wolverhampton Road) and you can find the main entrance to the hospital on **Pleck Road**. Walsall Manor Hospital is within easy walking distance of Walsall railway station and is well served by buses from Walsall bus station.

Car Parking

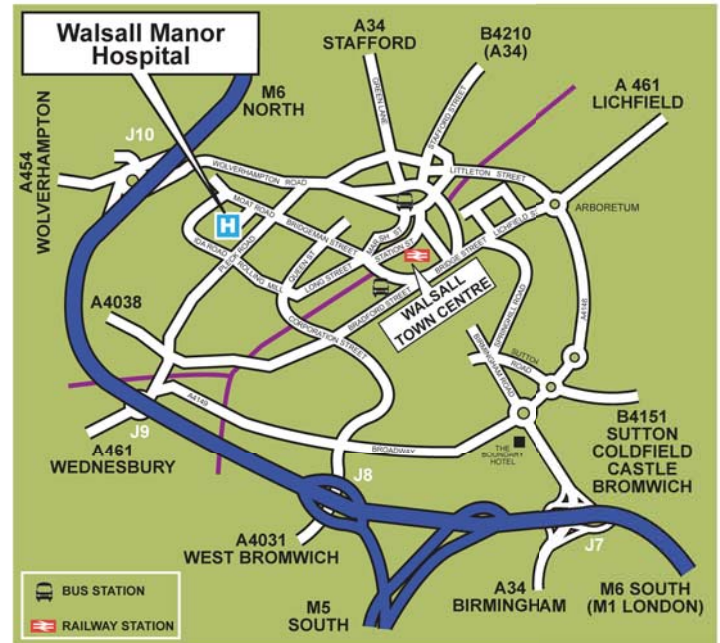
Patients and visitors to the hospital should park in the new main hospital car park (Car Park B) which is located off Moat Road. However, if you are going to Fracture Clinic, Accident & Emergency, or one of the wards in Modular Block, please use (Car Park D) as this will be more convenient. Car Parking charges

A 'pay on foot' system operates and the charge is £1 for 30 minutes, £2 for the first hour and £1 per hour for every hour after that up to a maximum daily fee of £6. Weekly concessionary passes are available for regular visitors to the hospital at a charge of £10 per week, please ask for more information in the ward or clinic you are visiting.

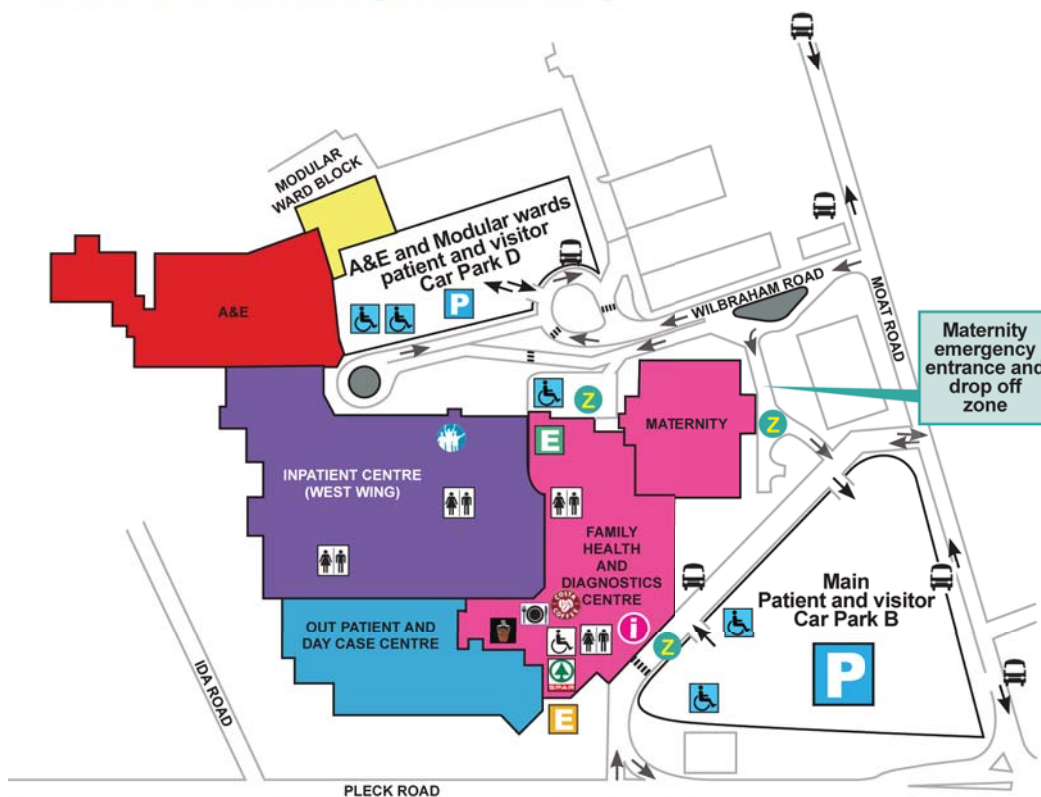
Disabled and priority car parking spaces

The new car parking facilities have provided more dedicated priority parking spaces for 'disabled blue badge holders' and there are now also 'parent and child' spaces available, both of which are located close to the main entrances. Providing more



of these dedicated spaces has resulted in the Trust taking the difficult decision that 'Disabled Blue Badge Holders' now have to pay the normal car parking rates. If you hold a Disabled Blue Badge you can access the priority car parking spaces but you will now have to pay the car parking fee.
