### Emerging Issues/Themes and Lessons to Share in the Network:

- A process for a joint death review with all the units involved in the baby's care would be beneficial.
- Issues related to understanding NTS operational policy, NTS takes over clinical management responsibilities only when they leave the unit .
- Inadequate documentation of discussion between receiving and referring unit in the notes. Discussion about who should arrange bereavement counselling in such cases.
- It is inappropriate to fill prematurity as cause of death. PM showed massive liver infarction. This demonstrated the role of PM in newborns.
