3.	<u>Matters Arising</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fiona Metcalfe introduced herself as the next Lead Nurse for Surgical unit at Leeds. This will be a slightly different role to Anne Aspin as she was a consultant Nurse. Fiona gave an example of what she will be concentrating on e.g. Education packages for earlier discharges</li> <li>JS stated the photo guide from Leeds re stoma care was very useful</li> </ul>	

4	<u>Apprenticeship</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DE working on advanced apprenticeship. NNU induction 18months lead to QIS. While doing induction supernumerary. 20% as apprenticeship off the ward classroom education to develop skills. Supernumerary important in retention of this workforce. Ensuring st goals are achieved first. Awaiting to go to HE England (last meeting cancelled) for permission to move forward. T/C is about keeping mum and baby together you do not get paid for location of the baby just because it is in a TC unit the baby needs to meet the criteria. What you get paid for is any care the baby received that relates to HRG tariff. There was a discussion about babies being brought in from home i.e. for phototherapy and mums to be resident with baby and what other units did? was this classed as TC. ? Maternity get enhanced postnatal care payment for some additional care of the baby on a postnatal ward.
