### Minimum set of guidelines

- Resuscitation and stabilisation of preterm infants
- Respiratory support in term and preterm infants
- ✓PN• Fluid management PN
- • Approach to antisepsis **Infection to Prevention control guideline**
- Management of seizures
- **E** Management of common surgical problems (**Needs updating = ratifying**)
- **E** Referral pathways
- **National**• Screening and (if relevant) treatment for retinopathy of prematurity

### FRAMEWORK?(NNAP)

- • Transfusion of blood products **thresholds/amounts?**
- • Management of common congenital abnormalities - ??Kidney?renal tract??
- • Palliative care - **have at some hospitals - framework for referral contacts**
- **E** Analgesia and sedation (**embrace drug chart/formulary monograph**)
- • Oxygen targeting and management (**Working group**)
- • Home oxygen pathway

- • Management of suspected sepsis **NICE=early onset**
