- An action plan has been agreed at Board level and with your Local Maternity Systems (LMS) an Operational Delivery Network (ODN) to address local findings from Avoiding Term Admissions Into Neonatal units (ATAIN) reviews.

- Progress with the agreed action plans has been shared with your Board and your LMS & ODN
