

Mortality Review Group (MRG) South Shared Learning Points – January 2019

- A post mortem should be offered to the parents of all babies.
- Placental histology should be requested for all babies that have required resuscitation at birth.
- If antenatal counselling is done in the regional FMU a letter detailing the discussions with the mother and her partner should be sent to them with copies to the GP and referring Obstetrician. This is particularly important if there have been discussions around resuscitation decisions.
- If a ventilated baby has secretions that are difficult to manage consider seeking advice from physiotherapists and PICU.
