

Ensure **BP cuffs** are correctly sized for the baby.



Have **blank paper** available at **resuscitation** for someone to make contemporaneous notes – then sign, date and file it in the baby's notes.



In the case of a **difficult airway**, consider asking **obstetric anaesthetist** for help – they are experts in the procedure of managing difficult airways.

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In **palliative care** cases cared for on labour ward, consider assigning a neonatal nurse to attend regularly to support midwives and parents.

iGel (laryngeal mask airway) can be used as part of **difficult airway management**.

Remember to prescribe **caffeine** following delivery in preterm infants who qualify.



If you are thinking **sepsis** give the **antibiotics** as soon as possible.
